


We want to know what you think about having a new rehabilitation centre near Loughborough





We are asking what you think about having a new rehabilitation centre near Loughborough with more facilities and beds, this would mean moving some services from Nottingham City Hospital.

The new modern, well equipped centre would provide rehabilitation services for patients.

We want to ask to you about building a new modern rehabilitation facility near Loughborough.



We think that a new, modern facility with all of the specialist people and equipment in one place will help patients get better, quicker.



This would mean patients who use Linden Lodge at the City Hospital, Nottingham would now be treated at a new modern building near Loughborough.



A new centre would be at the Defence and National Rehabilitation Centre near Loughborough, a place where injured soldiers go to recover from injury.



The new centre would only treat NHS patients. These patients would also be able to use the really good facilities that are used to treat soldiers.



We know patients who receive specialist care have a better chance of returning to normal life faster. The new centre will have a specialist team with modern equipment all under one roof to help patients get better, quicker.



What have people told us so far?

Some people thought that they might feel lonely being further away from home.
